1. Membership 1958-1959 indicated a 100%+ increase going from 75 to 165 — with 90 new members.
2. Recommendations for 1959-60
 - a. Initiate efforts to extend student memberships
 - b. Continue letters to members and regional vice-presidents — at least twice during the year.
 - c. Increase efforts to enroll additional police administrators
 - d. Increase efforts to maximize nationwide participation
 - e. Initiate efforts to contact specialists in allied fields — safety, traffic, engineering
 - f. Initiate efforts to extend probation and parole participation
 - g. Issue to all members a statement of membership qualification indicating professional dedication is a factor paramount to advanced degrees, lengthy experience, or high rank or status.
3. Col Follis will suggest, at Department of Defense, policy of memberships for key positions in enforcement and corrections areas regardless of incumbent.

4. Recommend, finally, that 1959-60 be projected as another 100% year and that efforts be intensified to publicize this goal to all members.
