
Certificate of deposit at bank, face value of \$1,000, is not included in cash.

Eight checks received since October 15, total \$80, not yet deposited.

NOTES

1. No bills have been received for Criminologica or any other claim, except those noted as expenditures above and one for \$5 to cover cost of post cards not yet paid.
2. Checks for subscriptions at \$5 and \$8 continue to be received, and are returned with statement of new charge of \$10, as instructed by the Executive Committee. No corrected payment for renewed subscription has been received. A specific notice should appear in the next issue of Criminologica. There is expanded subscription interest, but not at \$10.
3. Membership and subscription statements will be sent in December, as usual. However, since the position of Executive Secretary-Treasurer was divided into two, it should be determined who sends these invoices. As Treasurer, I urge that this division be reconsidered, since an organization of our size, with less than 300 paid members, does not require such refinement.
4. In 1968, I issued membership cards and a membership list printed as a booklet. In my notice to members, I stated that this would be done bi-annually. One list should be issued for 1970, but this must wait for the end of March, when all membership payments are due. However, cards or wall certificates must be approved now, to cover early payments; if they are approved.
5. There are only 21 student memberships at \$5. This shows little interest in this special category, and the cost of Criminologica is more than \$5.
6. No payments for pre-registration for the annual meeting were received.
7. The treasurer has no information about deposits for the trip to Japan
