Asst Professor of Criminal Justice College of Lib Art and Soc Sci University of Houston-Victoria

The College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences at the University of Houston-Victoria is accepting applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor of Criminal Justice.

Candidates will be required to teach in the Criminal Justice undergraduate and graduate program. The candidate will advise students and serve as a Master's thesis advisor for graduate students. Candidates are expected to participate in course and program development; pursue scholarly and professional activities; and perform all other related activities as required.

Required qualifications: A doctoral degree in Criminal Justice, Criminology, Criminal Justice Administration or a closely related Criminal Justice field by starting date; demonstrated excellence in teaching; evidence of scholarly and professional activities; teaching undergraduate face-to-face courses in Victoria, as well as online graduate courses; ability to teach a course in statistics and research methods.

Preferred qualifications: Preference will be given to generalists capable of teaching a wide variety of courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels, as well those who have interest in expanding on-campus research, service and extracurricular opportunities for students. Candidates who have taught face-to-face undergraduate courses and have demonstrated involvement with students on campus are preferred.

Applicants must submit an application online that includes:

1. cover letter
2. current curriculum vitae
3. list of three current recommendations from people who are in a position to know the applicant's expertise, with at least one addressing teaching effectiveness and at least one to address research and scholarly activities;



4. evidence of effective teaching (including student evaluations, if available);
5. a complete description of scholarly activities
6. copies of all college transcripts (official transcripts will be required of all finalists.)

The University of Houston-Victoria is a Hispanic-serving institution, located in the Coastal Bend region of southeast Texas. The main campus is in Victoria, TX, approximately 2 hours from Houston, Austin, Corpus Christi and San Antonio. It also offers a satellite campus in the greater Houston area. The University of Houston-Victoria enrolls approximately 5,000 students.

This position is located in Victoria, TX. The successful applicant is expected to play a large role in campus and student life in Victoria. The Criminal Justice program has an undergraduate program that serves both traditional college students on campus and distance education students. Courses in the undergraduate program are offered face-to-face in Victoria and online. The Criminal Justice program also has a Master's degree that recently began in Fall 2020. The graduate degree is offered online at this time.

Review of Candidates will begin May 13 and continue until filled. This position will start in Fall 2024.

A Closer Look at UHV

City Location

The University of Houston-Victoria is located in Victoria, Texas, the commerce and entertainment center of the Texas Coastal Bend region. Pioneer charm and high-tech industry mingle in the city of 62,000 inhabitants near the Gulf of Mexico on a popular coastal route between Houston and Mexico. Victoria is within a two-hour drive from Houston, Austin, Corpus Christi and San Antonio. As the third-oldest chartered city in Texas, Victoria has many beautiful, historic Victorian structures and homes. Additionally, Victoria's economy has grown to become the regional hub for neighboring businesses and industries.

UHV Location

The University of Houston-Victoria shares a campus with the Victoria College. The UHV campus includes the University Center, completed in spring 2000, which contains classrooms, offices, and media and computer labs, and University West, which houses classrooms and faculty and administrative offices. In 2004, a 14,000-square-foot expansion to the University West building was completed. The Jaguar Hall and Jaguar Court residence halls for underclassmen are a short, 10-minute walk to the main campus.

History

In the 1960s, the citizens of the Victoria area realized that greater opportunities were needed in higher education. No institution within a hundred-mile radius offered baccalaureate and master's degrees. Many junior college students and graduates in the region wanted to continue studying beyond an associate degree, and a growing number of people who had bachelor's degrees were anxious to pursue master's degrees. To meet those needs, UHV opened in 1973.

Accreditation

UHV is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools to award bachelor's and master's degrees.

Role and Scope

The University of Houston-Victoria is one of four universities in the University of Houston System. The primary role of UHV is to provide undergraduate and graduate instruction to students within and beyond the Texas Coastal Bend region.

Organization

UHV is governed by a Board of Regents and the Chancellor of the University of Houston System. Administrative responsibility is vested in the UHV President.

Offerings

The University of Houston-Victoria, located in the heart of the Coastal Bend region, offers courses leading to approximately 60 degree programs and concentrations in the schools of Arts & Sciences, Business Administration, and Education, Health Professions, and Human Development. A faculty of experts at UHV gives students individual attention to help them succeed, whether learning in a classroom or online. UHV offers face-to-face classes at two UH System teaching centers in Fort Bend County, in addition to its home campus in Victoria, and online courses that students can take anywhere. Since its founding in 1973, UHV has provided students with quality university education from exceptional faculty at a great value.
